FOOTWEAR

Equipment	Quantity	Comments	Check off
Water Shoes	1	Look for shoes with good foot and/or ankle support and sturdy soles. You will be canoeing & portaging in these shoes. Keens, Chacos, and Tevas	
Camp Shoes	1	Cross-trainers, tennis shoes, or hiking hoes in good condition for around	
Wool socks	3	Heavy wool, merino wool or rag or thick polypro. No cotton please	

UPPER BODY

Equipment	Quantity	Comments	Check off
Lightweight top	1	Athletic layer top, synthetic fabric	
Fleece layer	1	Zip up or pull over (nights can be chilly) A thicker fleece is recommended	
Rain Jacket	1	Should be water/rain proof not just resistant, and large enough for your	
Short sleeve top	2	Athletic fabric that dries fast	
Sports bra	2-3		
Sleep shirt	1	Cotton and designated for just sleeping	
Swim Suit	1-2	For canoeing and swimming	

LOWER BODY

Equipment	Quantity	Comments	Check off
Light pants	1	Leggings	
Fleece pants	1	Warmer pants with lining. Can be synthetic fabric pajama pants.	
Rain pants	1	Waterproof and big enough to fit fleece pants under.	
Shorts	1	Synthetic fabric, that dries quickly	
Underwear	5	Personal preference, but should be able to dry quickly	

HEAD

Equipment	Quantity	Comments	Check off
Warm hat	1	Fleece or wool	
Hat with brim	1	Can be a baseball cap, used for sun and bug protection	
Bandanas	1-2	Great for headband or sun protection	

SLEEP

Equipment	Quantity	Comments	Check off
Sleeping Bag	1	Recommended to have a synthetic bag rated 20 degrees Fahrenheit. Should be able to compress down to fit into a compression pack.	
Compression pack	1	This is for your sleeping bag. Your sleeping bag will have to fit into your pack, so you will need a compression sack to fit your sleeping bag into.	

PERSONAL GEAR

Equipment	Quantity	Comments	Check off
Sunglasses	1	Durable, won't break easily.	
Sunscreen	1	SPF 30 or highter	
Lip balm	1	With sunscreen	
Bug spray	1	Small bottle (non aerosol). Note about spray with DEET—Deet dewaterproofs your gear and gets into your skin. If you wear spray with DEETR, bring extra bananas to spray it onto and then tie around your head/arms.	
Water Bottle	2	Wide-mouth bottles with very few parts (no straws). Must hold 1 liter each. We pump water into our water bottles and the pump fits over the large mouth bottles.	
Toiletries		Toothbrush, glasses, contact supplies, etc	
Headlamp	1	Versatile tool that is hands free	

GUNFLINT BAG

We leave a bag at Gunflint that will contain your dry clothes and bus supplies

Equipment	Quantity	Comments	Check off
Bath towel & shower supplies	1	For showering when we return. Works best to share shampoo/body wash with others in your group so you don't all have to pack it or use travel	
Dry outfit	1	Shirt, pants, comfy clothes for trip back to camp.
