A few things to do over the next months:

February

- Feb. 2 Camp forms are available in CampMinder. Start working on them!
- Schedule an appointment for a physical to be done before May 1.
- Registration for CampMeds is open now (campmeds.com).

March

- Review the pre-camp packet with your camper when it arrives (first week in March).
- Check bag size (Maximum 42" long and 70 lb) and start thinking about packing list.

April

- Finish up with forms. Notify office of physicals coming after May 1.
- Firm up travel plans and enter into CampMinder.

May

- Start gathering items on the packing list.
- Schedule mandatory lice check with a lice company.
- Campers arriving on June 17 Last day to register with CampMeds without penalty is May 10.
- Campers arriving on July 14 Last day to register with CampMeds without penalty is June 10.

Two weeks prior to session

- Finish packing.
- Reduce exposure to germs (less travel, no large groups, avoid sick people).

One week prior to session

- Lice check completed and confirmation emailed to camp.
- Send a letter to camp for your camper.
- Review pre-camp packet to make sure you got everything!


