


Side Notes:




- ◆ New Campers should be hearing from their "Big sisters" this month and will be introduced in person at camp. Please let us know if they haven't heard from them.

Forms—Due MAY 1st:

- A photo of your camper is a required form. If your camper is returning, please replace old photo with a current one. This picture is used by counselors, the health center and office staff to help identify your camper even before they arrive.
- If your camper can't get a physical before May 1 due to insurance reasons (and you've told us) no worries. However, you will still get the "missing forms" reminder emails.
- Travel information will be ready this month to complete—It's also a required form.

FROM THE HEALTH CENTER

Any camper (except Rookie 1) who will be taking prescription medication(s), and/or daily vitamins or supplements while at camp **MUST** register with CampMeds. Questions regarding registration should be directed to CampMeds 954-577-0025. Epi pens and inhalers are 2 exceptions and should be physically brought to camp. Other exceptions are listed on page 27 of your pre-camp packet.

CampMeds Registration deadline for campers arriving:

June 17 is MAY 12th

July 14 is JUNE 12

Refer to pages 26-28 of your pre-camp packet for more CampMeds information.

Please register with Walgreens in case your camper unexpectedly needs a prescription filled. If your daughter intermittently needs an over the counter medication such as Tylenol, Claritin, etc. our health center is stocked with these and other OTC medications. Please make sure you have authorized us to dispense on the health history forms
