One we would like to particularly point out is our Expected Camp Behavior on page 13. An additional clause has been added to the parent and camper questionnaire stating that if a camper participates in bullying in any shape or form, including social media, it will affect their chances of being asked back to camp. Camper Travel



In the near future, we will need to know how your camper and her bags will be coming to camp. As soon as we "turn on" the travel section of CampMinder, an email will be sent out letting you know and give instructions on how to enter this information. Guess what, lots of information on travel can be found on PAGES 4-6. For those of you in the Chicago area, information regarding our bag service will be coming out to you as well.



CampMeds

Any camper who will be taking medication(s) while at camp MUST register with CampMeds (EXCEPTION: Rookie 1 campers do not need to register). This includes vitamins or supplements that are taken daily. If your camper unexpectedly needs an over the counter medication such as Tylenol, Claritin, etc. our health center will be able to supply that. Questions regarding registration should be directed to CampMeds 954-577-0025. Epi pens and inhalers are exceptions and should be brought to camp with the camper.

Registration MUST be 30 days prior to your camper's start date or a late fee will be assessed by CampMeds.
