Forms

(not due until May 1, but why wait)

We realize the mere mention of this word gives some parents PTSD, but we are committed to making your form experience top notch. Here are a few things that will help:

- Forms will be available the first part of January (exact date to be emailed).
- Using the Campanion app to complete your forms allows you to upload photos of certain forms instead of converting to them to pdf's first.(Physicians exam, immunizations, copy of insurance card)
- Please make sure to read the Acknowledgement of Rules over WITH YOUR CAMPER. Not knowing the rules is no excuse.
- Start early. Stress-the state of worry or mental tension caused by a difficult situation. This can be elevated by not waiting until the last minute.

CampMeds

Camp Agawak will again use Camp-Meds to handle all prescriptions and daily supplements including vitamins. Campers taking any of the the above must be registered with CampMeds at least 30 days prior to their session. There are a few medication exceptions. Please read the CampMeds FAQs under forms & documents in CampMinder. Campers not registered will be assessed a \$250 fee.

Rookie 1 campers are EXEMPT!
