A little Thanksgiving history

The tradition of giving thanks has been around for quite some time. The current ritual of feasting is modeled after the one shared in 1621 between the colonists and the Wampanoag people. The official "day of thanksgiving" was proclaimed on Oct 3, 1863 by Abraham Lincoln to be held on Thursday, Nov 26. This continued with President Roosevelt designating the fourth Thursday in November as Thanksgiving Day. The Macy's parade has been going since 1924. The parade was cancelled in 1942, 43, and 44 because helium and rubber were considered important for military purposes and not available for the large iconic balloons that were the hightlight of the parade.

The LODGE
